

Novell Client Installation:

for personal PC laptops

Fall 2005

NOTE: Before you begin installation of Novell, it is recommended that you print out this instruction sheet. Installation will require reboot of the computer, after which the user will need to input server tree information.

1. NOVELL CLIENT

Installing Novell Client

- 1) Open web browser and download the network client at: <http://www.novell.com>
- 2) Look for "Support" → "Downloads" near the top of the page and click on the link
- 3) Look for Novell Client
 - a. The popular download is Novell Client 4.91 for Windows 2000/XP, English.
 - b. File name for Novell Client 4.90 SP2 English: [clnt491e.exe](#)
 - c. Please note that this file name may change depending on Novell's release schedule.
- 4) Unzip the downloaded file. NOTE: make sure you know where you're unzipping it to.
- 5) Go to the folder into which you've unzipped Novell: English → WINNT → i386
- 6) Run application *setupnw.exe*
 - a. **IMPORTANT: RUN CUSTOM INSTALLATION.**
 - b. Check boxes:
 - i. Novell Client for Windows
 - ii. Novel Distributed Print Services
 - c. Okay default selections.
 - d. Reboot computer as prompted.
- 7) Login to Novell Client
 - a. First time only: click on the *Advanced* tab.
 - b. Under *NDS* tab, enter the following:
 - i. Tree: ced-tree
 - ii. Context: students.arch.ced
 - iii. Server: arch1.ced.berkeley.edu (note: in some cases, it may be arch2.ced.berkeley.edu)
 - c. Enter your User Name and Password.
- 8) Your machine may or may not require you to enter your WINDOWS login and password. This is the login and password you typically use to access your windows machine.
